At that time: As Jesus was setting out on his journey, a man ran up and knelt before him, and asked him, "Good Teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?" And Jesus said to him, "Why do you call me good? No one is good but God alone. You know the commandments: 'Do not kill, Do not commit adultery, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness, Do not defraud, Honour your father and mother.'" And he said to him, "Teacher, all these I have observed from my youth." And Jesus looking upon him loved him, and said to him, "You lack one thing; go, sell what you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; and come, follow me that saying his countenance fell, and he went away sorrowful; for he had great possessions. And Jesus looked around and said to his disciples, "How hard it will be for who have riches to enter the kingdom of God!" And the disciples were amazed at his words. But Jesus said to them again,

"Children, how hard it is for those who trust in riches to enter the kingdom of God! It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for a rich man to enter the kingdom of God." And they were exceedingly astonished, and said to him, "Then who can be saved?" Jesus looked at them and said, "With men it is impossible, but not with God; for all things are possible with God."

Peter began to say to him, "Behold, we have left everything and followed you. Jesus said, "Truly, I say to you, there is no one who has left house or brothers or sisters or mother or father or children or lands, for my sake and for the Gospel, who will not receive a hundredfold now in this time, houses and brothers and sisters and mothers and children and lands, with persecutions, and in the age to come eternal life."



Reflection

CHOICES WE MAKE

What is a choice—it is an deliberate act of choosing between two or more possibilities. This is part of our decision making process— a conscious act made with our mental faculty and sometimes also physical.

A young man or woman must make a choice of marrying somebody after a process of deliberation, and even after a period of engagement. Similarly young persons must deliberate on a choice of vocation to the priesthood or to the religious life after going through a period of discernment —the ability to show good judgment about the choice one is called to make, and all its implications.

Within the parameters of our faith the aspect of choice is paramount—the decision to follow Christ and the commitment it entails . Faith is a call and it evokes a response cf. the Lord chooses Abram—the call Gen.12,1-3 –Response- 12,4-5-“ He obeyed and left with his wife Sarai.” This is the classical choice made to Abram and his response. Today's readings— Wisdom 7:7-11 and the Gospel Mark 10,17-30

has the theme of choice, which entails renouncing other choices. Renunciation is also a deliberate choice of no longer behaving in a particular manner. In the rite of Baptism the candidate renounces Satan and all his works and pomps

Solomon made his choice of wisdom rather than the trappings of power and prestige, and renouncing, the goods of this world.

Similarly the story of the rich man who was challenged by Jesus to make a very committed and important choice—either follow him, giving up all his riches, or keep his goods and loose him. He failed the test when it came to the challenge of renunciation

In conclusion the letter to the Hebrews tells us that the word of God is like a double edged sword that penetrates deeply and uncovers all that is hidden in the human being .For all of this the word of God forces one to make a radical decision

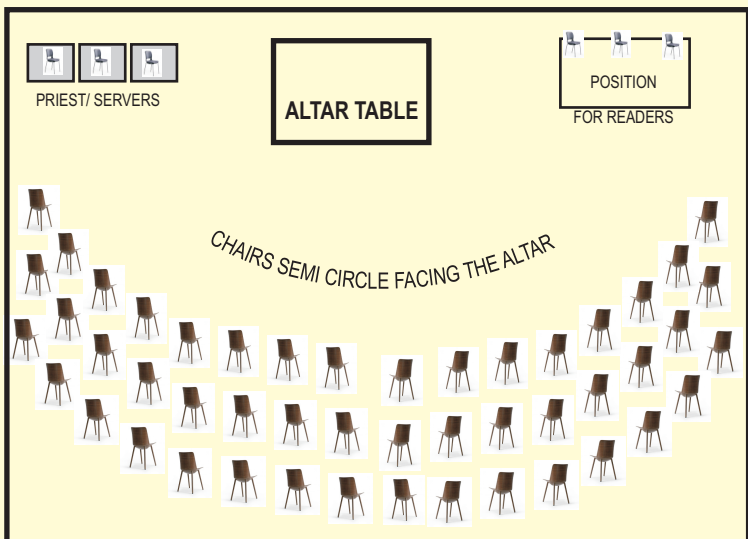

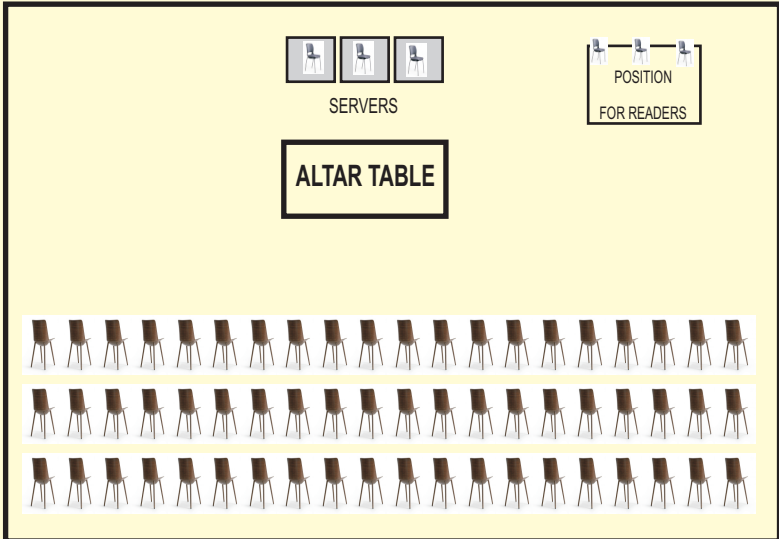

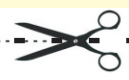
