

IDENTITY OF JESUS

he Evangelist Mark invites us to reflect on I the identity of Jesus. He was conducting a scientific opinion when he asks disciples who do people say that he is.

Then he asks a more important question who do you say that I am? Peter answers it correctly. "You

are the Christ".

The disciples were still learning what kind of Messiah Jesus was. To have the right answer revives our belief system as Jesus began talking about being rejected and even suffering by some religious leaders and even being killed.

This was not what Peter expected to hear. He may have missed the rising again part. He did not want

Jesus to talk about suffering and dying. He begins to tell Jesus "not at all" and Jesus rebukes him and even calls him Satan because he misunderstood the kind of Messiah Jesus was.

How quickly Peter went from the right answer to the wrong understanding. We too may have the right answer but the wrong idea. The other disciples realized that they still had to do some learning about Jesus and his mission and so do we.

We are called to be the disciples of Jesus, learners, people willing to keep on growing in awareness of Jesus and his mission.

Our learning is a process as we continue to reflect prayerfully on his word through the scripture and we see him in the gospel healing people, setting people free, not only from spiritual paralysis but also from their sin and guilt that ties them up, bringing people the good news that God loves

Jesus calls us his disciples to continue with his mission, to be missionaries bringing hope and

healing to our world.

In the Gospel Jesus reminds his disciples and us that being missionaries will cost us something which means dying to ourselves, keeping behind our selfishness, even being willing to cross barriers that can keep us from other people so that we can come to the point where we recognize and respond to the needs of all our sisters and brothers. If it means taking up our cross in a particular manner facing suffering and giving service to others like the first disciples.

Let us continue to learn what it means to be followers of Jesus. Missionaries willing to show

people by our lives who Jesus is.
